

Instructions For

Gifting of Personal Items Memo

Creating your Memo:

- Please provide a detailed description for each item to ensure it does not get mixed-up with another item
- Identify each recipient by full name and indicate your relationship to them
- Sign and date the Memo
- Store the executed Memo in a safe place, alongside your Will
- Inform your executor about the existence of your Memo

Our template allows you to add items and change gifts and recipients, without having to create a whole new Will.

Amending your Memo:

- Edits made to your Memo may be questioned for authenticity, even when dated and initialled. We therefore recommend completing a new template whenever you wish to make changes to an item or recipient.
- When storing your new Memo with your Will, make sure any previous copies are removed.
- Ensure that the gifts and directions in the Memo do not conflict with any specific gifts you have made in your Will, as the gifts in the Will take priority

Although your executor is not legally obliged to distribute your personal belongings in accordance with your Memo, you should feel confident that they will respect your wishes.
